



## **FOOTIE CAMP COORDINATOR – Job Description**

Free Footie is a non-profit organization providing absolutely free after-school soccer programming to nearly 2,000 of Edmonton's young people on an annual basis. We work with elementary school children aged 8-12 in some of Edmonton's most underserved areas.

As our Footie Camp Coordinator you will have some soccer experience, and you will have a lot of summer camp experience. Our camp is a person-first camp that of course endeavors to increase physical fitness and soccer prowess, but we are also in the business of developing incredible leaders who love both sport and their neighbor.

We are a lean organization, so if you are excited by the opportunity to create something new and troubleshoot on the fly then this is the job for you. This will be the third year we run Footie Camp, but we have completely broken the mold for the 2018 camp – that means that you get the chance to be part of something new and truly remarkable. You will be supervised by the Program Manager. This is a full-time position to be part of an inspiring children's camp from April 23 – August 10, 2018 (exact terms of the position are dependent on funding).

### **Responsibilities**

- Implement camp plan, as designed by the Curriculum Coordinator (April – June)
- Deliver Footie Camp training to coaches, with the support of the Curriculum Coordinator and Program Manager, if necessary
- Lead a team of Footie Camp Coaches (July – August)
- Be the main point of contact for parents of Footie Campers
- Ensure camp policies and emergency action plans are observed at all times
- Be aware of and properly handle issues children have outside of Footie Camp

- Standard First Aid – CPR C & AED
- Vulnerable Sector Police Information Check
- Availability to attend training May 26 and 27, as well as June 23 and 24, 2018
- Previous experience working with children
- Excellent knowledge of and interest in soccer
- Ability to work in a team-oriented environment
- Enjoy working with children
- NCCP/CSA Learning to Train certification

- Currently enrolled at a post-secondary institution in the area of Education, Child and Youth Care, Social Work, or related
